Q. What is the CLC?

A. The Community Learning Center (CLC) at Latonia Elementary School provides after school opportunities (clubs, organizations, workshops, special events, etc.) for academic enrichment, youth development, and family and community engagement. The CLC acts as an extension of the school day. By partnering with several community partners (agencies, individuals, school staff, etc.), the Community Learning Center at Latonia Elementary School is able to provide participating students with amazing opportunities outside of the normal school hours.

Q. What are the hours of the CLC during the 2015-16 school year?

A. Clubs and activities of the CLC occur after school. The CLC is open every day after school. The CLC runs Monday-Thursday each day after school until 6 PM and until 5 PM on Fridays (due to early dismissal). Additionally, the CLC may host special evening events throughout the school year.

Q. Who may attend the CLC?

A. The CLC at Latonia Elementary School has approximately 100 slots and currently has a waiting list. All students are welcome to apply to join the program; however, they cannot attend until enrollment and a start date have been confirmed with a parent/guardian by the CLC Coordinator.

Q. How does a student register with the CLC?

A. Students and parents/guardians must complete a registration form and behavior contract to be eligible to attend the CLC. Additional copies of the registration form and behavior contract can be found in the Latonia Elementary School office.

Q. Is food provided for participants of the CLC?

A. Yes. Snack and dinner are provided daily. Students receive snack immediately after school. Dinner is provided each day of programming (Monday-Friday) by the Kids Café Program from Cincinnati Cooks. Dinner occurs at 5:30 PM on Monday-Thursday and 4:30 PM on Fridays. Below is an example menu of a weekly dinner schedule:

Q. Is there transportation home from the CLC?

A. Yes. If a student participates in the CLC after school, he/she is permitted to ride the late bus home. Bus transportation is free and is provided by a yellow school bus. A bus monitor rides the bus with the bus driver and students to ensure safety. The late bus leaves Latonia Elementary School at 5:45 PM on Monday-Thursday and 4:45 on Fridays. Students may NOT ride the late bus without permission from the CLC Coordinator and if

they are not registered with the program. Students may be suspended from the late bus for behavior, etc.

- Q. What type of clubs and activities are included in the CLC?
- A. Clubs offered through the CLC include a variety of academic and enrichment focused activities. Directly after school (for approximately an hour) each day of programming certified teachers are available for homework help and tutoring. After academic time, students are dismissed to an enrichment club of their choice. Some clubs are available throughout the school year, while others may be offered only by quarter or semester. A large variety of clubs are offered, including but not limited to Chess Club, Art Club, Drama Club, Lego Robotics League, Fitness Rocks, Boy's Club, Girl's Club, and Tech Lab. Please see a schedule (by quarter) for days and times of each available club.
- Q. Does the CLC have rules?
- A. The CLC is an extension of the school day. School rules still apply at the Community Learning Center. There will be consequences for broken rules and misbehavior. This may include suspension or expulsion from the CLC.
- Q. Where does my student report after school?
- A. Students report to the cafeteria **directly after school** for snack. During the first hour of programming, students have time to work on homework, work with a certified teacher for assistance, read books, and participate in educational activities.
- Q. When is the CLC closed?
- A. The CLC is closed if school is not in session (holidays, inclement weather, when evening activities are cancelled, etc.).
